Members Challenges 2022. Themes to be advised General Conditions

- The Members Challenge was introduced to encourage Members to produce new Artwork to a given theme which means that old artwork will not be accepted as an entry in the Members Challenges. Entries should be produced over the last 6 to 12 months.
- Open to financial members only
- The size of the entry is not to exceed 1.2SqM. including the frame
- All paintings are to be ready to hang fitted with "D" Rings and Cords
- Artists name, title of the painting and sale price must be clearly marked on the back of the painting
- Presentations and socials will be held
- Entry forms will be available from the reception desk at the Gallery

Social Art Sundays: Bring any artwork or craft, anything you like, and enjoy the company of others in the gallery every Sunday from 9.30am.
